In addition to this, please find (below) an overview of the topics that we would have been covering this term. We understand that some children may like to take their own direction with some of these topics - creating their own projects after completing their own research or working with an adult (particularly with the foundation subjects) and this overview is intended to help with that.

Term 6

Year 3	Local area study
Maths	This term we will be looking at fractions and shape. Building on what we have already learnt we will be looking at, finding fractions of sets of objects and amounts, identifying equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and comparing and ordering fractions In shape children will extend their knowledge and understanding of 2D and 3D shapes, right angles in shapes and turns, and horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines.
English	Writing (Book: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe) We will be writing a story about adventure, mystery and friendship. While playing, Lucy and her siblings find the secrets of a wardrobe that lands them in a mystical place called Narnia. They find that Narnia is under an evil enchantment by the White Witch. Here they realise they were destined to join the adventure and unite with Aslan to defeat the White Witch. Children are encouraged to write their own story of discovery and adventure using the features we have been working on this year. It would be fantastic to see children's work including coordinating and subordinating conjunctions, direct speech between their characters and lots of lovely adjectives for description.



	Reading Read, read, read! Anything or everything. Read online interesting facts about your local area, where you live and the natural world. How about writing a book review or fact file on what you have read or learnt and fill your class teachers email inbox with alerts to let them know you've been reading!
Science	Local area study: This term we will be studying our local area. Describe the landscape around you. Why is it like this? How is it changing? What is causing it to change? What do you think about that? It would be great to share the picture of these with us! How about finding old picture books or using the internet to try and get a before and after picture of your area. Then writing a little piece of scientific research on how it's changed.
Foundation subjects/ project overview	Geography This term we will be continuing to look at physical and human geography of our local area. Maybe on your daily exercise you could log everything you see and separate it into human features or physical features. How about researching into how the different features effect or change the area? Also could you use a map and compass to locate an area? What are the key features on a map that help you? What do you notice that is different on a map? RE - Judaism We will learn about the origins of Judaism and its main beliefs. We will also find out who founded Judaism and where. We will be able to name and describe special Sikh festivals and the meaning of symbols. We will also learn what the Jewish Holy book is and how it is used and also learn about the special place in which Jewish people go to.
